PROPOSED REWORDING

- (a) Applicants for an examiner certificate shall undertake an Examiner Core Course followed by the a Examiner Standardisation Course related to the particular examiner privileges sought. These courses shall be provided by the competent authority or by an approved training organization and approved by the competent authority
- (b) the standardization course shall include, at east:
 - (1) 1 day of theoretical instruction;
 - (2) Observation of 1 skill test or proficiency test for the licences or ratings for which the applicant seeks the privilege to conduct tests and checks.

The **Examiner Core Course** is to cover the theoretical and practical principles of examining (see table below) and shall last at least two days.

This course shall contain instruction on the applicable requirements of Part-FCL and Part-Ops, the conduct of skill tests and proficiency checks, and their documentation and reporting.

Examiners shall also be briefed on the protection requirements for personal data, liability, accident insurance and fees, as applicable in the member state where they exercise their privileges

The **Standardisation Course**, which is to cover the practical aspects of examining for a particular license or rating, and will consist of a minimum number of days (see tables below). This course shall include Oobservation of 1 skill test or proficiency check for the licenses or ratings for which the applicant seeks the privilege to conduct tests and checks

(c) The standardization course shall contain instruction on the applicable requirements of Part-FCL and Part-Ops, the conduct of skill tests and proficiency checks, and their documentation and reporting.

Examiners shall also be briefed on the protection requirements for personal data, liability, accident insurance and fees, as applicable in the member state where they exercise their privileges.

This will include briefing, conduct of the skill test/proficiency check, assessment of the candidate to whom the test/proficiency check is given, debriefing and recording/documentation under the supervision of a senior examiner delegated by the Authority.
